

NEW CONNECTIONS

Generally, sanitary sewer extensions are constructed as areas annex into cities. In the past, we have also been able to extend our lines into areas of existing homes outside of cities and their urban growth boundaries. Failing septic systems have caused health concerns and connecting to our system has done much to make this valley a better place to live. In some instances, it may still be possible to extend our service lines into such areas. However, several land use laws limit this considerably. Someone who is having problems with their septic system should call our office so we can determine what may be able to be done. Providing such service helps to reduce health hazards and to improve the overall water quality of the valley.

Please be advised that all costs must be paid by the property owner, we cannot ask our current customers to pay expenses related to new services. We will, however, meet with property owners to help them decide if they can afford the construction costs. We may be able to help with financing and in some hardship instances, we can defer payments.
